



## COLLEGE STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Chancellor State College Parents and Citizens' Association, on behalf of the College community and the Executive Team of the College, has jointly determined that our College is a full-uniform College.

Our College community believes that our uniform is important because it encourages a sense of self-esteem, pride in our College and self-discipline in students. Our College uniform is designed to create a sense of unity and respect in our College and with unity comes strength and a real sense of purpose. The wearing of the College uniform also contributes to student safety by ensuring outsiders to our College community are readily identifiable.

All students are expected to observe the details of the College uniform while on their way to, during and from College. If a student does not meet uniform requirements on any school day, a note must be supplied from a parent/guardian. The student may then acquire a Uniform Exemption Pass, or a loan uniform from our supply pool to be returned after laundering.

Chancellor State College is a sun safe school and a College Bucket Hat is to be worn while outside.

## PRIMARY SCHOOL

### Day Uniform

The day uniform consists of a Chancellor polo shirt with shorts or a skort can be worn each day. This uniform is encouraged for physical activities.

### Formal Uniform

**Girls** - uniform consists of a Chancellor blouse to be worn with navy skort or navy shorts. A Chancellor dress is also available.

**Boys** - uniform consists of a Chancellor navy shirt to be worn with either navy shorts or cargo shorts.

Please note that students may be given directions about wearing the formal uniform for specific occasions/events. It is not required that students own both uniforms unless requested specifically.

For official sports days and sport house events, students may wear a shirt in their relevant sport house colour.

### Winter Uniform (Term 2 & 3)

Students may wear the winter polar fleece jacket or sports jacket with the College logo purchased from the uniform shop. Students may also wear plain navy track pants. Girls may wear navy or black tights underneath their skorts or dress.

### Footwear

For safety reasons it is compulsory that children wear enclosed shoes to College. **All shoes must be totally black, cover the foot in accordance with safe work practice. From year 5 to year 12, students are required to have shoes made of non-pervious materials.**

Canvas and high-cut shoes, including boots, are not appropriate. White socks that are visible above the line of the shoe are to be worn as part of the uniform. Sport-specific shoes may be worn for sport and/or HPE but students must change into these shoes at the time of the class and change back into their black shoes following the class.

## SECONDARY CAMPUS (Year 7-12)

### Footwear

For safety reasons it is compulsory that students wear enclosed shoes to College.

**All shoes must be totally black, cover the foot and made of non-pervious materials in accordance with safe work practice.** Canvas and high cut shoes, including boots, are not appropriate for general day use. White socks that are visible above the line of the shoe are to be worn as part of the uniform. Sport-specific shoes may be worn for sport and/or HPE but students must change into these shoes at the time of the class and change back into their black shoes following the class.

### Winter Uniform (Term 2 & 3)

Students may wear the winter polar fleece jacket or sports jacket with College logo and Chancellor long trousers purchased from the uniform shop, or plain full-length navy track pants purchased from the uniform shop. Track pants must not display logos, stripes, brands or additional colours. Girls may also wear navy or black tights.

Year 12 students have the option to purchase a personalised jacket at the commencement of Year 12.

## JUNIOR SECONDARY (Year 7 – 9)

### Day Uniform

This uniform consists of a Chancellor navy polo shirt with Chancellor day shorts purchased from the uniform shop, (worn at a minimum of mid-thigh length, not rolled or adjusted).

### Formal Uniform

**Girls** - Chancellor jade/navy blouse to be worn over the Chancellor navy/jade inverted pleated skirt or Chancellor navy shorts (worn at a minimum of mid-thigh length, not rolled or adjusted).

**Boys** - Chancellor jade/navy shirt to be worn over the Chancellor navy shorts.

Please note that students may be given directions about the wearing of formal uniforms for specific occasions.

## SENIOR SECONDARY (Year 10 – 12)

### Day uniform

This uniform consists of a Chancellor white polo shirt with Chancellor day shorts purchased from the uniform shop. (worn at a minimum of mid-thigh length, not rolled or adjusted).

### Formal Uniform

**Girls** - Chancellor white blouse with College tie to be worn over the Chancellor navy box pleat skirt or Chancellor navy shorts (worn at minimum of mid-thigh length, not rolled or adjusted).

**Boys** - Chancellor white shirt to be worn over the Chancellor navy shorts.

Please note that students may be given directions about the wearing of formal uniforms for specific occasions.

## Dress Standards for all students

Inappropriate dress must not be worn to College at any time. Inappropriate is defined as clothing or apparel that is, or could be deemed to be:

- offensive due to being revealing or containing inappropriate logos/wording
- unsafe for students and others
- likely to result in a risk to the health of the students or others
- unacceptable writing or skin marking including temporary tattoos
- not sun safe

## General Appearance

Hairstyles must be neat, clean and tidy. All hair ornamentations should be kept to a minimum and may include scrunchies, ribbons and elastic bands in College colours of navy, jade, white and gold. All students with long hair (below the collar) are required to tie their hair back for Primary Students or when directed by staff in practical areas such as Science, Food Technology, HPE and ITD for health and safety reasons

No makeup or false nails/fillers are permitted for Primary students. Coloured nail polish is not to be worn at the College. Students will be asked to remove it if worn.

Secondary students' makeup and nails must be of a natural appearance. Any false nails or ridge fillers must be of natural length and colour. If students do not adhere to false nails or ridge fillers reflecting a natural look or length, they will be required to cover them with medical grade adhesive tape.

Jewellery must be kept to a minimum to maintain a neat and natural appearance and to ensure the school uniform is worn correctly. For health and safety reasons, students may be required to remove jewellery that is excessive or poses a risk to themselves or others.

Should there be any concerns regarding a student's adherence to the uniform policy, parents will be contacted by an appropriate staff member to collaboratively develop a plan to ensure the student returns to the correct uniform standard.

## General Appearance

On nominated days, students may be permitted to wear free dress as part of a school-approved fundraising activity. On these occasions, students are required to wear appropriate and modest clothing in accordance with the Dress Standards for All Students outlined above. Clothing that does not meet these standards must not be worn. All usual health and safety requirements continue to apply on free dress days, including the wearing of enclosed shoes and approved jewellery only. In cases of non-compliance, parents/carers will be contacted and students may be withdrawn from the activity until appropriate attire is provided.
