



Prep Term 2 Learning

English

Traditional Tales

We will be exploring the parts of a story and recalling an event of a traditional tale. We will continue learning about the links between letters, sounds and words to write simple words. We are learning to identify and produce rhyming words.

Mathematics

We will be continuing to build our maths skills and understandings. In number, we will count to and from 20 and we will be making links between number names, numerals and quantities up to 10. In measurement, we will compare objects using length and mass.

SCIENCE

We learn that all objects have observable and describable features. Using our senses and through exploration and discussion, we will develop the language to describe the properties of the materials from which objects are made. The properties of a material make it useful for certain tasks.

HASS

We will be learning that all places have observable features and that these features can be represented on different types of maps and models. We will be using the language of location.

The Arts

Music

This semester Prep students will be learning lots of counting and action songs. Our focus is learning routines so that we can all enjoy the music room safely. We will learn about some unusual percussion instruments and how to play them and look at songs that tell a story. We will also be exploring and improvising on the keyboards with a buddy.

HPE

In this unit, students will learn how to develop fundamental movement skills that help them run, jump and throw. Students will participate in non-competitive athletics events at the College's Annual Sports Day. They will also practise personal and social skills to help interact respectfully with others.
