Persuasive Texts

Students will learn about persuasive techniques to write to convince others about a range of topics. They will also learn about persuasive speeches. Students will then give a short speech to convince their peers about who in the school deserves an award.

HASS

Volunteers

Students will learn about how important volunteers are in our community. They will then decide on a volunteer who works at our school who deserves an award for their hard work.

Mathematics

- Students will continue working with numbers up to 9,999. They will represent and partition numbers in standard and non-standard ways using Part-Part-Whole.
- Fractions Students will learn about basic fractions as part of a whole and also as part of a set of objects.
- Students will learn about the relationship between addition and subtraction and recognise matching stories for these.

- Money Students will look at representing amounts in different ways and adding small amounts of money.

Students will learn about heat energy and heat transfer. They will conduct fair tests and learn about insulators and conductors.
