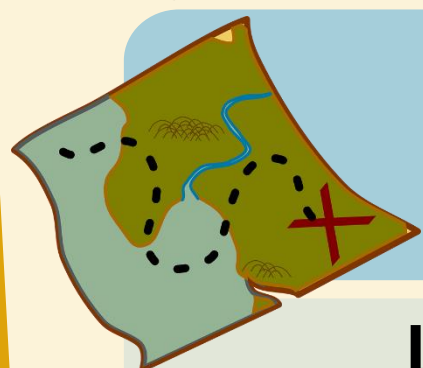




Year 5 Term 2 Learning



English

Let's Go on a Quest!

Students will read and explore the narrative Deltora Quest. They will learn how complex sequences are created through flashbacks and shifts in time, and explain how ideas are shown through characters, settings and events. They will then write their own story based on the book.

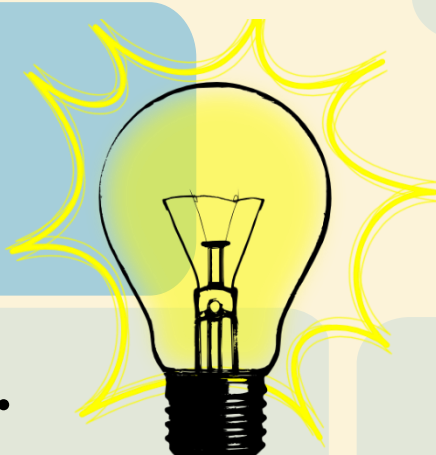


Mathematics

Measure It, Halve It, Calculate It and Spend It!

Students will order and locate unit **fractions** on a number line, add and subtract fractions, and continue patterns by adding and subtracting fractions. Student will investigate **measurement** – they will calculate length and determine the perimeter and area of rectangles. Students solve simple problems involving the four operations using a range of strategies and explain plans for simple **budgets**.

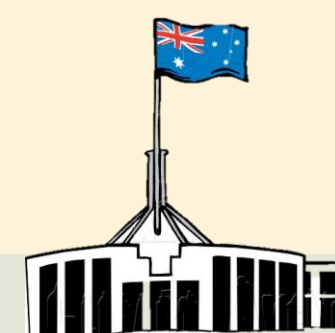
Science

Students will learn through a variety of investigations that light from a source forms shadows and that it can be absorbed, reflected and refracted.

Democratic Citizens

Students will learn and be able to explain all about the key values and features of Australia's democracy include how to vote, who can vote, be voted in and what is the expectations of people involved in the process. Students will also be learning about what it means to be a citizen and community groups that work together to achieve a civic goal.
