English

In English this term, the students will be:

- investigating the detailed structure and language choices used in persuasive texts
- exploring how language choices change based on the audience of the text
- responding to literal and inferential questions when reading various texts



Science

In Science this term, the students will:

- understand that while all plants and animals have features in common, their observable features can be used to sort them into separate groups.
- investigate if things are: living, non-living, once living or a product of a living thing
- explain the processes of living organisms, such as growing, moving, sensitivity and reproducing



Arts

In the Arts this term, students will:

- understand that dances represent a story or mood
- create, rehearse and perform a dance
- discuss differences and similarities between dances



Mathematics

In Maths this term, the students will be:

- identifying odd and even numbers
- working with numbers up to 10 000
- solving problems using addition and subtraction
- representing money in a variety of ways, and counting out change
- modelling and representing fractions as a line, shape and collection



HASS

In HASS this term, the students will be:

- comparing life on the Sunshine Coast in the past and present
- identifying what natural and built features have changed over time
- creating questions to find out more information about life on the Sunshine Coast in the past
